LANGUAGE PLANS WILL WIDEN ACCESS TO PUBLIC SERVICES IN WELSH

COMMENTING on today's announcement that the Assembly Government plans to specify 57 more public service bodies under the remit of the Welsh Language Act, Shadow Heritage Minister Paul Davies AM said:
